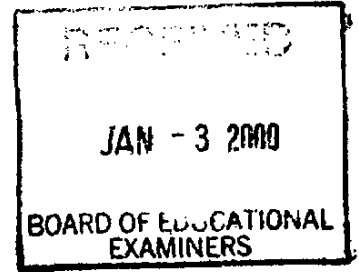

RESPONDENT'S APPLICATION  
FOR REVOCATION OF HIS  
TEACHING LICENSE

I Daniel Colsch swear or affirm under oath:

1. I currently hold a valid Iowa Teachers License.
2. I understand that following criteria of professional practices may have been violated:

**12.2(1)(c)**

as evidenced by the State's prosecution and my guilty plea in Linn Count AGCR 034994 (see Exhibit 1).

3. I understand that no formal proceedings have been filed before the Board, and further understand that the Board has legal authority to exonerate, warn or reprimand me as a licensed individual, following a Board investigation into allegations of conduct volatile of Board criteria and of the Board's authority to suspend or to revoke my license for conduct volatile of Board criteria.

4. I am aware of the Board's legal authority to exonerate, warn or reprimand me as a licensed individually, following a Board investigation into allegations of conduct volatile of Board criteria and of the Board's authority to suspend or to revoke my license for conduct volatile of Board criteria.

5. Without admitting or denying the allegations, I do waive my right to formal charges and my right to a formal hearing, and ask the Board to accept this waiver and to permanently revoke my teaching license with no possibility of reinstatement.

6. I understand that by waiving formal hearing, I do not waive my right to notice of the Board's proposed decision, nor my right to appeal therefrom or to seek rehearing under the provisions of Iowa Administrative Code 282-11.11 and 282-11.12.

Having acknowledged my rights as outlined above, I hereby formally waive my right to a hearing before the Board and request that my license to teach in Iowa be revoked. I affirm that my decision is made voluntarily and knowingly.
