FINAL ORDER


This matter came before the Board of Educational Examiners upon Complaint filed May 6, 2005, alleging violation of Board rules 282 Iowa Admin. Code 25.3(1)(b) and 25.3(1)(c). On July 29, 2005, following investigation of the Complaint, the Board found probable cause to move this matter to hearing.

Pursuant to Board rule, a practitioner may voluntarily surrender the practitioner's license if the practitioner waives the right to hearing before the Board and notifies the Board of the intent to surrender his or her license. Upon receipt of a voluntary surrender, "[t]he Board may issue an order permanently revoking the practitioner license . . ." 282 I.A.C. 11.4(6). On November 29, 2005, the Respondent submitted a notarized letter to the Board as a formal surrender of his coaching authorization and waiver of his right to hearing on the allegations. The surrender was presented to and accepted by the Board at a meeting held on December 9, 2005.

Order

THEREFORE, the Board acknowledges the Respondent's voluntary surrender of his coaching authorization and incorporates his action into this Order by attaching a copy of the Respondent's letter to this Order. In accordance with this filing, the coaching authorization issued by the Board to the Respondent and his privilege to serve as coach in Iowa schools is **PERMANENTLY REVOKED** with no possibility of reinstatement.

To Whom It May Concern:

Please consider this letter my formal surrender of my coaching certificate obtained through your department. By surrendering my license I am not making any type of admission of guilt or misconduct. I am, however, in agreeing to surrender my current certificate also agreeing that my surrender will be permanent and that I will not be allowed to re-apply for any type of teaching and/or coaching certificate again in the State of Iowa. I am not eligible for reinstatement.

By this letter I am also formally acknowledging that I have a right to have a contested hearing concerning any potential allegations against me. By surrendering my license in leu of any hearing I am foregoing any right to a hearing and indicating that I wish to voluntarily cease from formal coaching in the State of Iowa.

I further understand that this Board will post the surrender of my license without the possibility of reinstatement with the NASDTEC (National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education & Certification National Clearinghouse).
